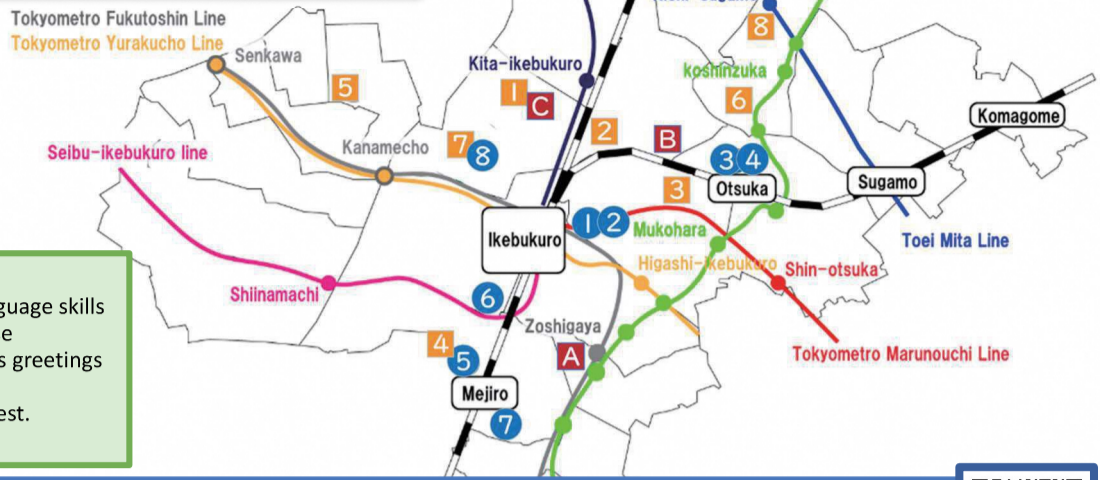
Map of Japanese Learning in Toshima City
